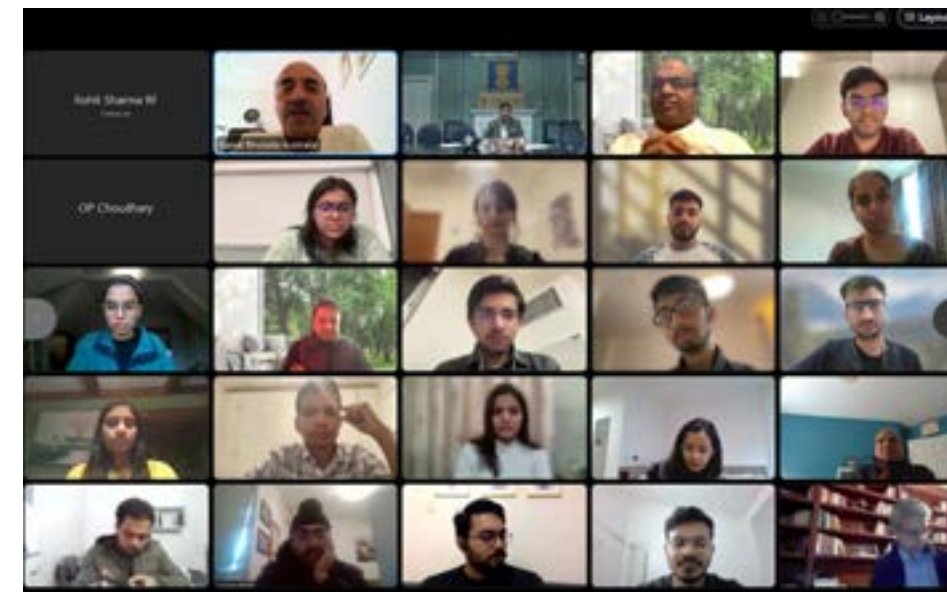
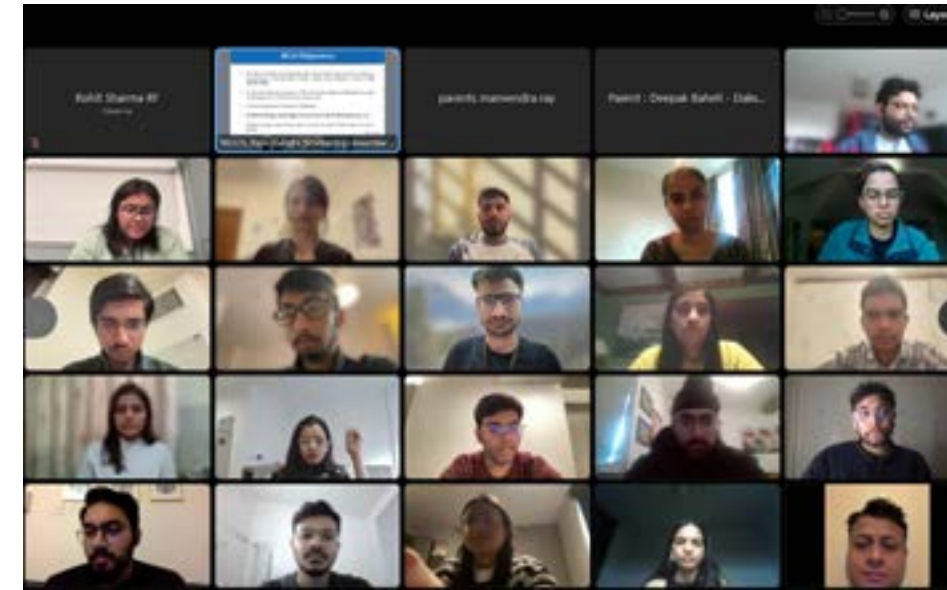

Under this scheme, all those students of the state who desire to pursue their higher education at a foreign university will get monetary help. Deserving students have also been given amount of more than 50 lacs in few cases. All the students who are going to pursue undergraduate level, Master's level, and Ph.D. and Post-Doctoral research programs from a university established abroad can grab the benefits of this scheme.



With the initiative of Rajasthan Foundation, a constructive dialogue was held between officials and the students who had joined from numerous countries including USA, UK, Canada, Germany, Australia, Netherlands, Singapore, Hong Kong etc.
