(On-The-Spot Artificial Limb Fitment Camp)

Disability Rehabilitation in India and abroad particularly because most of self-disabled are below the poverty line and still cannot afford limbs available in market.

The Proposal is to channelize the synergies of following three associations to service the mankind and provide the artificial limbs to the handicap not only in India but internationally also.

Bhagwan Mahaveer Viklang Sahayata Samiti (BMVSS): It is the world's largest organisation rehabilitating over 1.95 million disabled. BMVSS's cost of one limb is INR4500 vs USD\$10,000 offered by its similar counterparts globally. BMVSS has held more than 82, on-the-spot, limb fitment camps in 35 countries across the world.

Rajasthan Foundation with its strong global member/associate network could possibly bring in the donations and also identify the pain points, provide the ground support such as identifying the worthy recipients, complete background checks and accumulate medical history of the intended recipients, seek local administration permissions, provide logistical support to visiting team of BMVSS, assist in conducting the actual camp and as required provide feedback.
