KNOWLEDGE SERIES



DEPARTMENT OF DOMESTIC & OVERSEAS RAJASTHANIS AFFAIRS

DORA engages and supports NRRs by strengthening cultural ties, facilitating investments and providing welfare services. It consolidates the link between Rajasthan and its diaspora, ensuring their active participation in the State's growth while addressing their needs and concerns globally.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

A dedicated provision on the State Government's Sampark Portal allows NRRs to register grievances online. This single-window system ensures timely and effective resolution of their concerns.

NODAL OFFICER IN EVERY DISTRICT

A senior officer has been appointed in each district of Rajasthan to resolve NRR-related concerns locally, enabling faster and more effective support for diaspora members in their native places.

RAJ NIVESH PORTAL

A single-window platform for investors through the 'One Stop Shop' (OSS) facility in the Bureau of Investment Promotion (BIP), offering time-bound clearances, online submissions with e-payments, real-time tracking and updated policy information to enable transparent and hassle-free investments in Rajasthan.

FAST-TRACK MOU IMPLEMENTATION

Investors, including NRRs, who signed MoUs during Rising Rajasthan can track the progress of their projects online. The system provides real-time status updates and also allows investors to request meetings with the concerned departmental Secretary, making the MoU implementation process more efficient.

IDENTIFYING GAP AREAS

District Collectors highlight priority gap areas which are shared with NRRs. These are matched with donor Pravasi Rajasthanis who express intentions for philanthropic contributions, thereby creating partnerships that address local priorities and support community development.

FACILITATION OF PHILANTHROPIC CONTRIBUTIONS THROUGH A PORTAL

To enable meaningful engagement of non-resident Rajasthanis (NRRs) in the development of the State, the Rajasthan Foundation has consolidated gap-area information from all districts and developed a comprehensive online Portal.

The Portal provides district-wise details of identified gap areas in sectors such as education, medical & health, animal welfare, environment etc. including

the concerned village or block, together with the estimated financial requirement for each area. Additionally, contributions can also be made in projects & sectors other than the ones mentioned on the portal.

Information on departmental Sahbhagita Schemes and contact details of respective District Collectors and designated nodal officers for issues relating to NRRs are also available on the portal.
